## Significant performance improvements

Jolly Phonics had a significant impact on Windham Primary School in Southern Maine. Before implementing the program, only a few students read beyond level 4 in the Kindergarten Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA).
However, after adopting Jolly Phonics, many students reached DRA4 and even higher levels, with some reading a year or more above their grade level. This new approach reduced below-grade-level numbers by one-third compared to 2017, and by over one-half compared to 2016 and 2018.

Moreover, the percentage of students ending their kindergarten year above grade level more than doubled compared to 2017 and tripled compared to 2016 and 2018.


On average, the number of students performing well below or below the benchmark dropped from $55 \%$ to $27 \%$, while the number of students performing above the benchmark rose from $17 \%$ to $46 \%$.

## What a daily phonics lesson looks like:

Jolly Phonics has always focused on direct, explicit instruction of phonemic awareness and phonics for both reading (decoding) and writing (encoding). Each lesson begins with a story to strengthen phonemic awareness and encourage vocabulary development. The program teaches the students to say the individual sounds and blend them into a word for reading; for writing, the students listen for the sounds in a word and then write the letter(s) that represent those sounds and so spell the word. From the start, the lesson plans provide explicit direction and practice in letter formation and introduce segmenting and writing words at an early stage. As their letter-sound knowledge increases, the students are able to blend and segment more and more words automatically, as well as developing and extending their comprehension skills.

The image and description of the action for the letter sound.

## 3. Letter Formation

1. Learning the letter sounds

Children are taught the 42 main letter sounds. This includes alphabet sounds and digraphs, such as /sh/, /th/, /ai/ and /ue/.

## 2. Learning letter formation

Using different multi-sensory methods, children learn how to form and write the letters.
3. Blending

Children are taught how to blend the sounds together to read and write new words.
4. Identifying the sounds in words

Listening for the sounds in words gives children the best start for improving spelling.

## 5. Learning tricky words

Tricky words have irregular spellings and children learn these separately.

## Letter sound order

The sounds are taught in a specific order (not alphabetically). The first group has been chosen as it makes more simple three letter words than any other six letters. This enables children to begin building words as early as possible.

## Structured lessons for teaching phonics.

A year's worth of engaging daily lessons are provided in the two write-in student books divided into three steps. Comprehensive and detailed lesson plans for each of the pages in the student books are included in the teacher's book.


Student Book 1 covers the daily lessons for Step 1 and the first six weekly units in Step 2.

## Step 1

- Introduces the main letter sounds of English, each with its own story and action.
- Shows students how to use their letter-sound knowledge to read and write simple regular words, providing daily practice in blending and segmenting.
- Teaches the first set of tricky words.

Step 2

- Builds and consolidates the skills taught in Step 1.

- Introduce and review the main alternative vowel spellings, capital letters, alphabet and new tricky words. Step 3 introduces <ph>, soft <c>, soft <g>, and the /air/ spellings.
- Offer a variety of guided writing, dictation, and reading com-prehension activities that introduce basic sentence structure and reading for meaning.
