

A Glimpse into Heaven

Throughout the scriptures we've been given peeks into the structure of Heaven. However, they were written in cryptic for which without the keys, read as fictional fantasy. Fortunately Daniel provided us with the keys to translate.

In the Center is the Throne of God, surrounded by four beasts with heads symbolizing the four corners of the Zodiac.
