Adding the chemical process of alkaline hydrolysis (accelerated decomposition of human remains) in the Crematorium definition.

ALLOW HUMAN REMAIN EFFLUENT IN THE SEWER?

Chemicals used to treat and dispose of human remains will enter the public sewer system and also reclaimed water uses.
