The desire for spiritual pasture is a deep-seated one in the center of our being. The hunger is to fill the void created by the absence of God from the soul. Whenever a soul encounters God, such a soul is fulfilled and is at rest. St. Augustine opens his confessions with this fact about God and the soul: "you have made us for yourself, our heart is restless until it rests in you" (BK. 1, Ch. 1) The place of God in the soul is the green pasture where the soul finds repose. When the twenty-third psalm says: "Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose" (Ps. 23:2), it refers to the peace of soul which the Lord gives. Green in this case speaks of life, and Christ has promised us life in abundance (Jn. 10:10). This life is the life of God which he communicates to us through Christ. Until we seek and find this life, the fulfillment we desire will not come. **Exerpt from Fr Amadi's Weekly Reflection.
