Rosary:

The rosary for the faithful departed will be done USUALLY before the Mass on the same day. In some cases, you may recite the rosary the evening before but we MUST check with the Priest to be sure that it is approved. The person leading the Rosary may respectfully go to the pulpit.

There may be a Eulogy after the rosary but NOT during the Mass. Please keep the Eulogy 5-10 minutes long.

DO NOT MAKE PLANS BEFORE WE HAVE DAYS AND TIMES APPROVED AND PLEASE DO NOT MAKE ANY CHANGES ONCE THE ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE.
