Message from the Pastor

Praying about church finances. Thank you to the many faithful people of this congregation who support our mission with their gifts of treasure! Your generosity allows us to worship, pray and study together, provide meals to veterans and the needy, send food to our neighbors, care for shut-ins, mentor children, serve our community, and so much more. We are blessed to be a blessing to our neighbors!

To keep our ministries going, we need your financial support. For the first time in several years, our pledge drive for 2018 fell \$20,000 short of meeting our budget. Giving was impacted by some families moving from our church, other families who usually pledge didn't, and some families have never pledged.

Your pledge is crucial. It allows us to budget, which allows us to move forward in ministry. I've been praying about this daily since the beginning of the year, and I'm asking you to join me. Please raise up with me prayers that the money will be found, that our ministries will continue to serve and grow, that we will continue to be an outpost of the Kingdom of God for our community, and that we will be enabled and empowered to make disciples.

It's never too late to pledge. Pledge forms are located in the narthex of the church and in the church office. Drop them in the offering plate, or in the offerings box in the church work room.

Matthew 6: 21 says, "...where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." My heart is with God and with his church in Rockton, and I know yours is too.

Rockton Caring Network. Your Vision Team has batted around an idea to make our church a center of community giving. When our church is mentioned, or when people are looking for a church, we would like them to say that Rockton UMC cares about their neighbors.

With that in mind, we are looking at creating a caring network to engage our neighbors in our ministry. John Carlton and I were invited to talk to the staff at Hononegah High School about this idea. They are right now collecting food for homeless high school students, and we will take it to Caritas when they are ready.

Caritas is currently serving 97 (97!) homeless high school students by weekly giving them bags of microwavable meals. You are invited to join this effort. Please bring soups with pull tab lids, Spaghetti-O's with pull tabs, Hormel Completes, Dinty Moore Beef Stew, tuna in a pouch, and Campbell's Ready Meals to church and leave them in the bin in the narthex. Paula Davis at Caritas tells me that these items are the hardest for Caritas to get donated, probably because they are a little more expensive than other types of food.

Try to imagine the high schoolers you know or have known not having a home to call their own. Try to imagine negotiating school, adolescence and the challenges of early adulthood without the stability of a home. Our donations can take a major burden from them and make a difference in young lives. Please pick up a few items when you go to the store.


