

RODS & HARDWARE

When choosing rods for draperies, there are several options to consider, each offering a different aesthetic and functional appeal.

Curtain Rods- the most common choice, available in a variety of materials such as wood, metal, or plastic.

Traverse Rods- designed for pleated curtains, allow for easy opening and closing, either manually or with a cord mechanism.

Tension rods- a great option for lightweight drapes or for spaces where drilling is not an option, such as in rented apartments.







Decorative finials can be added to the ends of rods to give a personalized and stylish touch. Each option allows for a range of design choices to match the style and functionality needed for your space.



Rings are used in conjunction with curtain rods to help the curtains slide smoothly. Often made of metal, wood, or plastic, they are attached to the top of the curtains and then slide along the rod.



Tiebacks are decorative pieces, typically made of fabric, rope, or metal, that hold the curtains open when you want to let in more light or create a structured look. They come in various designs, from simple loops to intricate, ornate styles, and can add a finishing touch to the drapery.



ROMAN SHADES







Flat Fold

- Shade is flat when completely lowered
- Requires the least amount of stacking space for soft shades
 Most popular shade style as it showcases any fabric (patterned or solid) perfectly

Relaxed

- Soft folds at bottom hem will remain in any shade position
- Suggested for outside mount only

Hobbled

- Folds remain when shade is completely lowered
- May require dressing as shade is raised and lowered to keep folds looking voluminous
 Pattern disruption may occur as folds overlap one another



Knife Pleat

- Stiffener dowels sewn into pockets on the back of shade
- Creates crisp folds with little need of dressing when raise and lowered
 Pattern disruption may occur as pockets are sewn from face of shade to back, tucking pattern into folds



Ribbed Pleat

- Stiffener dowels sewn into pockets on the face of shade
- Creates crisp folds with little need of dressing when raise and lowered
 Has dimension on face of shade
- when completely lowered
