DMU – C3

DEER

Antler regulations

All antlered deer must have at least 2 points (1 inch or more in length) on one side to be legal to take. Hunters 16 years of age and older may not take during any season or by any method an antlered deer that does not have an antler with at least 2 points.

Zone C

- Archery season: Sept. 15 – Oct. 14
- Crossbow season: Sept. 15 – Oct. 19
- Muzzleloading gun season: Oct. 20 – Nov. 2
- General gun season: Nov. 3 – Jan. 20

Daily bag limit: 2 deer

Possession limit: 4 deer

Deer-dog training season

Zone C: Sept. 29 – Oct. 18

TURKEY (gobblers and bearded turkeys only)

Fall seasons

Zone C

- Archery season: Sept. 15 – Oct. 14
- Crossbow season: Sept. 15 – Oct. 19
- Muzzleloading gun season: Oct. 20 – Nov. 2
- Fall turkey season: Nov. 3 – Dec. 30 (1)

Spring season

North of State Road 70

- Youth turkey weekend: March 9-10 (2)
- Spring turkey season: March 16 – April 21

QUAIL

Statewide Nov. 10 – March 3

Daily bag limit: 12

Possession limit: 24

Rifles, shotguns, pistols, muzzleloaders, air guns (air guns may not be used to take quail), crossbows and bows may be used. Gray squirrel and quail also may be taken during archery, crossbow and muzzleloading gun seasons using the respective methods of take allowed during those seasons.

BOBCAT

Statewide Dec. 1 – March 31

OTTER

Statewide Dec. 1 – March 1

Bobcats and otters may be taken by rifle, shotgun, pistol, muzzleloader, air gun, crossbow or bow.

Bag limits: No limit on bobcats and otters

Rabbits, wild hogs, raccoons, opossums, skunks, nutrias, beavers and coyotes

Daily bag limits: 12 rabbits. No limits on other species.

Possession limits: 24 rabbits. No limits on other species.
