

General Club Meeting

February 1st, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 7:33pm by President Doyle Ridgeway. All Board members were present.

The Secretary Patrick Neenan read the minutes of the June meeting and the special meeting in October. A motion was made by Robbie Rewis to accept with Dennis Mills seconding.

The Treasurer Tom LaFlam read the financial report. A motion was made by Robbie Rewis to accept with M.G. Ridgeway seconding.

Kenny Porter was nominated by Curtis Gore and seconded by Chris Williams. A motion to cease nominations was made by M.G. Ridgeway and seconded by Lebo Mathis.

The President Doyle Ridgeway opened nominations for the Secretary position held by Patrick Neenan. Patrick Neenan was nominated by Dennis Mills and seconded by Lebo Mathis. A motion to cease nominations was made by M.G. Ridgeway and seconded by Jeff Williams.

The President Doyle Ridgeway opened nominations for the President's position held by himself. Michael Mills was nominated by Charlie Watson and seconded by Curtis Gore. Doyle Ridgeway was nominated by Adam Lovvorn and seconded by M.G. Ridgeway. A motion to cease nominations was made by James Jennings and seconded by Jason Wright.

The President Doyle Ridgeway spoke about opening up the killing of does in archery season and the club getting doe tags for the youth to use in general gun season. A motion was made by Robbie Rewis to get the doe tags and seconded by Chris Williams. This will go on the June ballot.

A motion was made by Wayne Driggers to have a 1 day doe day during general gun season. This was seconded by Dustin Crews. This will go on the June ballot.

A motion to take does in archery season and get 35 doe tags for the youth 16 and under to use in general gun season was made by Michael Mills and seconded by James Jennings Jr.. This will go on the June ballot.

A motion was made by Tommy Joe Bond to go by the States' rules relating to does. This was seconded by Chris Black and will go on the June ballot. The discussion on does ended after this motion.

The President Doyle Ridgeway asked for a few half paying members to talk about how to pay the lease. Jeff Williams was first to speak about the current dues and half paying members and about the 30k the club has in the bank. Mr. Dennis Mills was next to speak about the dues and half paying members. He suggested that everyone pay \$1000.00 with a cap of 150 paying members. Mr Green spoke about half paying members and the vote to remove them in previous times, also about the assessment between all members.

President Doyle Ridgeway called to a 10 minute recess for the board to discuss matters. This was at 8:18 pm.

The meeting resumed at 8:28 pm, President Doyle Ridgeway told the members the board has done away with all the game managers and that there will be no honorary members this year. If the previous honorary members want to hunt in Crane Bay, they will have to pay dues.

President Doyle Ridgeway then told the members, the due dates for dues had to be moved up to March 15th due to the landowners moving up the lease payment due date to June 1st. After March 15th a \$100 late fee will be charged till April 15th. After April 15th a existing member will have to re apply and will be put in the list of new members who will be take till the club reaches capacity. Robbie Rewis protested the decision to move the dates up.

President Doyle Ridgeway then told the membership the dues for 20-21 will be \$2000 but everyone will pay half, so everyone will pay \$1000 and the books will close once the club reaches 150 paying members. Tommy Joe Bond spoke about disapproving of the boards' decision on the dues for next year.

A motion was made by Charlie Watson. That all board members, except the secretary and treasurer should pay dues. This was seconded by Curtis Gore.

A discussion was held between the members and the board on the dues for next year and an argument ensued.

A motion was made by Adam Lavvorn to adjourn the meeting and seconded by M.G. Ridgeway.

President Doyle Ridgeway adjourned the meeting at 8:45pm.
