from the Mayor's desk -

First snow!... and now it's winter. Thanks Rod, for clearing the roads so quickly on the night of the Council meeting.

At the November meeting, Council appointed Darren Anderson to the available Council seat (two-year remaining term). A new President of Council will be elected at the December meeting.

At the January 2020 Council meeting, two Council seats will be available for appointment by Council (4-year term for each seat). Anyone willing to serve on Council should attend the January meeting.

Council has requested that the Neave Township Trustees propose a contract for Council to consider for Village payment to the Township related to the Transfer Station. If provided, the contract is to include a guarantee for the Transfer Station to be open for the life of the contract and the Township to give notice to the Village prior to closing the Transfer Station. If a contract is provided, it will be discussed at the December 9 council meeting.

A Wayne Lakes Community - Sewer Project Information meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, December 17 at the Community Building.

The meeting will be hosted by Brice Schmitmeyer, President of Access Engineering Solutions. Brice will provide an update to the community for current status of the project and plans for funding applications and other next steps, including initial billing to begin in 2020.

Council approved the Village entering into two maintenance contracts for 2020 that will ensure adequate snow removal (Rod McNutt) and grass mowing (Dave Flatter) for Village roads and properties.

Fresh Aire Farms (Dan Young family business) provided a leaves-only dumpster for the first Wayne Lakes Fall Leaves Cleanup. The dumpster was kept for several weeks and was used by many. With use and no abuse, there may be dumpsters provided in the future.

The Community Building had a roof repair done by Rich Roofing on Monday, November 11 – before the snow! – that should stabilize the roof so that a total roof replacement can wait until 2021.
