## RESOLUTION # 2022 -9-12-51

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN INTERIM SANITARY SEWER BILL FOR SANITARY SEWER PURPOSES UPON ALL RESIDENTIAL LOTS WITH A DWELLING/STRUCTURE IN THE VILLAGE OF WAYNE LAKES, OH

WHEREAS, the council of the Village of Wayne Lakes has determined it to be necessary and in the best interests of the Village of Wayne Lakes to construct a sanitary sewer system in the Village, and

WHEREAS, such a project as the development of a sanitary sewer system for the Village of Wayne Lakes will require substantial funding, part of which will necessitate the Village of Wayne Lakes incurring an indebtedness, and

WHEREAS, in order to reduce the amount of funds which will be needed to be borrowed and thereby, to reduce the total cost of the project, the council of the Village of Wayne Lakes has determined it to be necessary and appropriate to enact an interim sanitary sewer bill to build up a sanitary sewer fund, now therefore,

BET IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Wayne Lakes, OH a majority of all members elected thereto concurring, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u> That there is hereby enacted a Sanitary Sewer Fund Interim Sanitary Sewer Bill to each and every owner of a lot with a dwelling/structure which will be required to be serviced by the sanitary sewer.

<u>SECTION 2</u> That the Interim Sanitary Sewer Bill shall be made quarterly commencing on January 1, 2023 and shall be in the amount of One Hundred Thirty-Five dollars (\$135.00) per quarter being Forty-Five dollars (\$45.00) per month.

<u>SECTION 3</u> That the funds derived from the Interim Sanitary Sewer Bill shall be placed in a separate Sanitary Sewer Fund and said funds shall only be used in relation to the development of a sanitary sewer system for the village.

SECTION 4 After construction bids are received and construction is at 75% complete for the sanitary sewer system project, this interim sanitary sewer bill will be raised to cover all debt, treatment, operations, maintenance, capital replacement, reserve account, and any other costs associated with the sanitary sewer system.

<u>SECTION 5</u> That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
