**Fishing Tips!!** Best freshwater fishing times...seasonal lake turnover refers to the exchange of surface and bottom water in a lake or pond. This annual recycling program happens twice a year, changing the freshwater fishing environment of the lake or pond, which in turn affects the best time to go freshwater fishing. There's spring turnover and fall turnover with summer stagnation in between. During spring turnover, water at the top warms while the bottom stays cool; during fall turnover, warmer water stays insulated at the bottom by the colder water at the top.
