The village chipper is not meant to be the only resource a resident has for making beautification improvements on their property. The village will make a reasonable effort to help with these piles. Chipping will begin in the month of May. This ensures that no more surprise snow comes our way, while using the truck. For residents with major jobs they want completed, please contact your local landscaper or rental company for the equipment that you need. Thanks for your support. As a reminder, do not use Lake Chippewa for dumping.
