from the Mayor's desk ---

At this time, the November election will not include candidates for either the mayor position or the two Council positions with terms ending this year. What is required and possible for next steps is being explored. Also, there still is one open council seat with about a 2-year term remaining that could be appointed at the September 9 council meeting. If anyone is interested in being on council, call 937.459.4111 and leave your name/phone number/Village address prior to the September meeting.

There are several Council decisions scheduled to be made yet this year regarding a Village Office, the Beach in 2020, future lakes management plans, and Phase II of the Sewer Project. For each, let Council members know your thoughts to guide their decisions to be representative of the residents and property owners in Wayne Lakes.

The 2019 *Hooked on Fishing – Not on Drugs!* event was considered a success by the organizers and attendees. If you are interested in becoming a *Hooked on Fishing* event organizer, call John Winger 937.678.7864.

Wayne Lakes Beach is closed for the 2019 season. Those involved feel there were several lessons learned that can inform future use of the beach. An interesting finding was that approximately 70% of the people who came to the beach this summer do not live in Wayne Lakes. If you have thoughts about plans for the future use of the beach, let Council know. Further discussion of plans for the beach in 2020 will take place during the September 9 council meeting.

Based on a more complete understanding of the contract terms for the proposed nanobubbles trial on Shawnee Lake, that lakes treatment has been put on hold. Instead, Shawnee and other lakes have been treated and the effects are starting to and will continue to become more apparent.

A plan for stocking triploid grass carp (do not reproduce) in some of the lakes this fall and how best to maintain that over the years is being put together. This natural lake treatment (they eat lake weeds and algae!) was strongly recommended as part of the SOLitude lakes assessment discussions.

For more information about the lakes, to share concerns and solution ideas, and to volunteer, attend the Lakes Mgmt. Council Committee meetings the first Tuesday of each month at 7:00pm at the Community Building.

A next round of roads patching will be underway soon. This will complete that work for 2019 with anticipation that little would be required again until the possible roads work related to the sewer project. Work to alleviate the Cucumber overflow issue also will be underway soon.
