TWO VERY IMPORTANT MEETINGS ARE BEING SCHEDULED:

- 1. **SEPTEMBER 18TH AT 7:00 P.M.** UPDATE ON THE PROGRESS THAT IS BEING MADE IN REGARD TO THE VILLAGE SEWAGE SYSTEM PLAN. REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE DARKE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT WILL BE PRESENT AS WELL AS BRIAN MAY FROM ACCESS ENGINEERING. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR THE FUTURE OF OUR VILLAGE.
- 2. **OCTOBER 16TH AT 7:00 P.M.** MEET THE CANDIDATES FOR THE UPCOMING NOVEMBER ELECTION. EACH WILL SHARE HIS OR HER MOTIVATION FOR SEEKING THE MAYOR POSITION OR COUNCIL SEAT. AN OPPORTUNITY FOR QUESTIONS WILL BE PROVIDED.

RUNNING FOR MAYOR: ELLEN BROWN AND PHIL CAPP. RUNNING FOR FOUR OPEN SEATS ON COUNCIL: INCUMBENT JOAN FALKNOR, INCUMBENT KAREN SINK, AND MELISSA CAPP. THE FOURTH SEAT WILL BE APPOINTED BY THE ELECTED MAYOR.

November 7, 2017 GENERAL ELECTION IMPORTANT DATES

October 10: Deadline to Register to Vote *Please note* If you register or update your information *after the deadline*, the change will apply for the *next election*.

Here are ways to register or update your address to vote:

- 1. ONLINE AT: https://olvr.sos.state.oh.us/
- 2. **IN PERSON:** At any county board of elections or the Secretary of State's Office.
 - At any public high school or vocational school.
 - At the office of any Bureau of Motor Vehicles.
 - Public libraries.
 - County treasurer's office.
 - Designated agencies include the following state or local public offices that provide public assistance or state-funded programs primarily engaged in providing services to persons with disabilities:
 - Department of Job and Family Services
 - o Department of Health
 - Department of Human Services
 - o Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services
 - Department of Developmental Disabilities
 - Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities
 - Ohio's four-year state-supported colleges and universities

3. BY MAIL:

- You may request a registration form from the board of elections, license bureau, libraries, or the Secretary of State's office by mail, telephone, in person or by having another person obtain it for you. After completing the form, return it to the board of elections or Secretary of State's office by mail.
- Mailed registration forms sent to a county board of elections or the Secretary of State's office must be postmarked 30 days before an election to be valid.

November 7: General Election: Polls are open from 6:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.

Early In-Person Voting:

Begins **October 11** and includes the Saturday, Sunday and Monday Before Election Day

November 1 - 3: 8:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

November 4: 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

November 5: 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

November 6: 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Election Day: November 7 General Election.
Polls Open 6:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.


