***Brice with Access Engineering joined our meeting via teleconference for updates.*** We will reapply for the EPA funding this coming summer in 2021. This is the majority of our project funding. We should expect a decision by October of 2021. If approved, we should expect bids in 2022 and potential construction in 2023.

***Income surveys*** needed for the Community Development Block Grant. Volunteers from the village will be making door to door visits to complete this process. Potential funds can be used for upcoming projects in our village to span the next 5 years. Our deadline is approaching soon. Call ins to the office are welcome.

***Darke County will be trimming trees.*** Be aware that there will be people on the roadways trimming and removing dead trees. Please have an extra set of eyes on the road and please **slow down** while driving through our park during this time. We want the workers to have safe conditions to complete the tasks at hand.

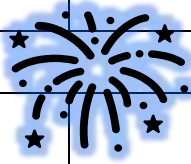
