Brice with Access Engineering and the Wayne Lakes Sewer committee continue to work on the upcoming project. Governor DeWine approves \$500,000 grant for our community using the H2Ohio Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant. Ohio EPA approves the 4 million in principal forgiveness the week of November 1, 2021. The first round of HB168 Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant Program was denied. Hopes are that there may be a second round of grants considered. We will keep you informed on all updates.

Electric Aggregation Program. Residents are currently receiving many letters from electric suppliers wanting your business. By opting out, you will no longer be in the village program. Please visit Energy Choice Ohio.Gov for more information and to help you understand how the program works. Dynegy was the previous supplier who's contract expired with the reading this month. The new supplier will be Energy Harbor 866-636-3749. Residents should receive letters soon showing this as our new Electric Aggregate contracted supplier for the village program. If you opted out and later want to join back in you will need to follow the guidelines provided by your supplier choice.

Drainpipe project now complete! Big Thank you to all the residents that helped with this project and made it possible.

Quotes are soon to be secured to include repairs to the dam on North Drive, also a drainage problem on East Drive. More info to come.

Verizon has installed a new cell phone tower on State Route 127 and McNutt Road. Reports from Neave Township state it is now working. It may not be at 100% power yet. More info to come.

Daily Fishing Passes can be easily purchased at the village office, Brewer's Gatehouse, on our Village of Wayne Lakes.com website and our The Village of Wayne Lakes facebook page. Please share with your friends!! The village has collected \$16572.00 so far this year!!

LAKE MAINTENANCE PERSON



To maintain, clean, and control water flow with the village.

This job will require an individual to visually inspect the water levels and drainpipes on a regular basis throughout the year. (ice off until ice on)

In the Spring, the pipes will require removal of bark and debris from the winter.

As the trees release seed pods, etc. the drains will need a bi-weekly cleaning.

Water level control will require watching the weather. Spring rains and valves will need to be closed and pipes open. Dry Summer days will require valves open, and pipes maintained.

Fall into Winter is a daily cleaning of leaves and controlling water levels.

There are several pipes that require putting cleaning tools together and cleaning before they become a problem. Assistance from a 2nd person will be required.

It is highly recommended that all pipes be cleaned out with these tools two to three times per year.

Removal of aerators, 2, from lakes in the winter months.
