Vandalism continues to be observed. Please report anything that is out of the ordinary to the Sheriff office at 937-548-2020. We are reviewing the current curfew ordinance, with the assistance of the Sheriff's office. Updates will be shared in coming weeks. Residents please call the village office to identify streets that need additional lighting.

Brice with Access Engineering provided an update for sewer project progress. He is continuing to meet with representatives of New Madison, Darke County, USDA and others to solidify plans. For village awareness, survey crews will be out and about our properties in the coming weeks.

Most residents have now received their letter regarding requests for information. The sewer project committee is compiling an accurate homeowner/renter list. Thanks to the many people that have already emailed and called in your current information. We appreciate your help! For those who have not responded, please do so by email or leave a message at the village office. Messages are checked throughout the week and weekends.
