At this time there are two council seats available. The council seats will be for a 4 year term for each seat. Council has approved increased patrols by the Darke County Sheriff department. Vandalism continues to be observed in our village. Please report anything that seems out of the ordinary to the Sheriff's office at **937-548-2020**. Council will review sheriff patrol needs again at the February 10 council meeting.

Please contact the village office with suggestions of locations for new streetlights in our village.

Brice with Access Engineering provided an update for sewer project progress at the January council meeting. He will continue meeting with representatives of New Madison, Darke County, USDA and others to solidify sewer project plans. The construction start date, for example, may be moved up to as early as 2022. For village awareness, survey crews will be out and about our properties in the coming weeks.
