*Happy New Year!***...Welcome 2022.* A fresh calendar encourages us to fill in the blanks with ambitious projects for home and personal improvement. My hope is that we continue to make improvements to our village and strive to be better at our normal day to day tasks. Let's all make this a good year to remember.

Brice with Access Engineering and the Wayne Lakes Sewer committee continue to work on the upcoming project. Governor DeWine approves \$500,000 grant for our community using the H2Ohio Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Grant. Ohio EPA approves the 4 million in principal forgiveness the week of November 1, 2021. We will keep you informed on all updates.

Electric Aggregation Program. Residents are currently receiving many letters from electric suppliers wanting your business. By opting out, you will no longer be in the village program. Please visit [Energy Choice Ohio.Gov](http://EnergyChoiceOhio.Gov) for more information and to help you understand how the program works. Dynegy was the previous supplier who's contract expired with the reading this month. The new supplier will be Energy Harbor 866-636-3749. Residents should receive letters soon showing this as our new Electric Aggregate contracted supplier for the village program. If you opted out and later want to join back in you will need to follow the guidelines provided by your supplier choice.

East Drive broken tile has been repaired. We are currently looking into the dam on North drive for repair. Cold patch will be used on Hickory Drive to fill in all of the potholes this month.

The Village has hired a new maintenance person for our lakes. Tim Weidner has been chosen to perform the duties needed for this year 2022. Please contact the village office if you have any concerns or issues with your nearby lake.

Verizon has installed a new cell phone tower on State Route 127 and McNutt Road. Reports from Neave Township state it is now working. It may not be at 100% power yet. More info to come.

Daily Fishing Passes can be easily purchased at the village office, or on our Village of Wayne Lakes.com website and our The Village of Wayne Lakes facebook page. Please share with your friends!! The village has collected \$16579.00 for the year 2021.

Please STOP dumping branches, yard waste and trash at the Chippewa property. Council approved \$2500 for Darke County to begin the cleanup of this property. This project is completed. Plans to make a parking area for boat access are underway. Chipping to be done twice a year to eliminate this problem. Please contact the village office for a designated time for chipping, if needed.
