With so much negative news out there, it was pure joy being a part of the festivities. Many thanks to everyone that made this celebration possible.

Doing summer maintenance on your property? Please inspect trees and bushes that are near the roadways. With many of our single lane roads, visibility becomes a problem. If you need help or assistance with your bushes or trees, please contact the village office.

Comply with the Ohio leash law. Residents are reporting dogs loose on neighbors' properties. In Ohio, dogs must be physically confined or restrained or properly leashed and controlled by a person. If this is not observed, complaint letters will be sent to residents that are not in compliance.

Brice with Access Engineering and the Wayne Lakes Sewer committee continue work on the upcoming project. A visit to a nearby village that currently has the new system will be scheduled soon. New Madison will be scheduling a tour of their water treatment facility. Lastly, a CDBG Income Survey letter will be sent later this summer to our residents for their completion. We can't stress the importance of staying connected to all of our sewer updates. Each phase of the project needs all of our help and support. Future grant opportunities are possible with the return of these letters. Watch for door hangers for Access Engineering associates regarding assessing electricity units and sewer tank locations on each property.


