# Governor DeWine Issues Statement on the Passage of House Bill 168 Highlighting Administration Priorities

One of the 4 key provisions \$250 million to establish a Water and Sewer Quality Program to provide grants to Ohio's counties, townships, and municipal governments to strategically address serious water issues that have been building in Ohio for decades and ensure communities have clean and safe water. The Ohio Department of Development will administer this priority initiative. The Village will keep you informed about how this latest piece of legislation potentially helps our project.

Brice with Access Engineering and the Wayne Lakes Sewer committee continue to work on the upcoming project. Village council plans to have Brice attend our monthly council meetings every other month going forward. Residents are encouraged to attend, watch the live stream or send in questions prior to the meeting for review. The village is currently applying for funds from The American Rescue Plan Act. Guidelines will be followed closely to ensure no repayments are requested in future dates.

**Wayne Lakes garage sales.** The last weekend of July has been chosen. Start setting up as soon as Thursday, July 29th through Sunday, August 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Chipping has started**. Please have branch piles that are easy to handle and close to the road. If you want to have volunteers ready to assist, that would be a great help.

**Daily Fishing Passes** can be easily purchased at the village office, Brewer's Gatehouse, on our Village of Wayne Lakes.com website and our The Village of Wayne Lakes facebook page. Please share with your friends!! The village has collected \$12981 so far this year!! If funds are available, stocking the lakes will be on our agenda for the fall time frame.

**Council approved the new Junk Vehicle Ordinance**. The solicitor for our village recommended a new version to keep current with neighboring villages.

**Please STOP** dumping branches, yard waste and trash at the Chippewa property. Council approved \$2500 for Darke County to begin the cleanup of this property. Clean up is scheduled for October.
