From the Mayor's desk –

The *Hooked on Fishing – Not on Drugs!* event began June 5 and will continue every Wednesday during June and July. To volunteer this year (families are required to have 1 adult for every 5 children) or if you are interested in becoming a *Hooked on Fishing* event organizer, call John Winger 937-678-7864. In support of this event, the Village obtained a grant to stock fish, had the portable toilets cleaned, and treated Iroquois Lake three times.

The 2019 trial of a Village-managed Swim Beach and FoWL-managed Beach Concessions continues. A bit rocky to begin, with some weather and other issues, and hot food prep is still pending, but the Beach is scheduled to be open weekends until the last day open this year on August 11. Encourage everyone in the Village to support the Beach.

Sauk Lake, nearly solid with surface algae and affected by other less-visible nuisance plants, was treated on Monday, June 3 by SOLitude Lake Management Company based on their lakes assessment results. Sauk was selected for SOLitude to showcase what they could do for our lakes. Just look at it now!

One common SOLitude recommendation for nearly all the lakes is underwater aeration. A fairly new aeration and more technology called “nanobubbles” could be an effective (and non-chemical) way to treat our lakes. To learn more about it come to the Friends of Wayne Lakes informational fundraiser in July – see the FoWL section of this Newsletter for details.

Many roads have been patched throughout the Village, with a bit of finishing still to be done. A ‘Stop’ sign will be placed at West Drive and Highland. A ‘Caution – Children at Play’ sign will be placed on Center at Cross Drive as a reminder to drivers to slow down and watch carefully for children in that area.

Important Reminder – Now, this year, is when to pay estimated local income tax to RITA, so when you file 2019 taxes in 2020 you have prepaid so you will not owe it all at once. If you have not received notifications from RITA, that does not exclude you from being required to pay estimated tax this year if you are supposed to file next year. 
Remaining 2019 Mosquito Spray Schedule around 10:00 pm each date, weather permitting
