Cicadas Brood X black-billed cuckoos are voracious cicada predators and take full advantage of emergences such as Brood X. Cuckoos are fascinating and poorly understood birds. Two species occur in Ohio: black-billed and yellow-billed. Although they look like songbirds, cuckoos do not belong to the order. Naturalists described "flocks" of cuckoos descended on insect emergences in the late 1800's. Brood X zones will provide food aplenty, and hopefully scores of little cuckoos will result. Council did a second reading of our new Junk Vehicle Ordinance. The solicitor for our village recommended a new version to keep current with neighboring villages. We are currently making revisions. One revision is to allow residents 30 days to make arrangements for a junk vehicle.

Please STOP dumping branches, yard waste and trash at the Chippewa property. Council approved \$2500 for Darke County to begin the cleanup of this property. Clean up is scheduled for October.

Two applications have been submitted for grants. One application has been denied. We were given reasons that our project was not large enough for the infrastructure grant, also not enough households were affected by the drain pipe project to qualify. We were told funds should be coming soon for the American Rescue Plan Act. We will review guidelines provided and proceed accordingly. Project will begin this year.

Next council meeting Monday, July 12, 2021, 7:00pm in the council meeting room. Due to Covid 19 restrictions, we will plan to have an open meeting at the Village office.
