Welcome Spring. This Sunday March 20 is the first day of Spring. People are chomping at the bit to buy their fishing passes which start April 1, 2022, through March 31, 2023. Annual non-resident passes will soon be available online along with our Daily passes. Visit our website Village of Wayne Lakes.com.

Property visits will begin in mid-March time frame to discuss tank placement on each individual site. Please watch for door hangers and Access Engineering employees walking through the park. Darke County will be coming to Wayne Lakes in March to trim our village trees and bushes on village property near the roads. Please use caution while driving during this time.

Daily Fishing Passes can be easily purchased at the village office, or on our Village of Wayne Lakes.com website and our The Village of Wayne Lakes Facebook page. Please share with your friends!! The village has collected \$35.00 for the year 2022. Volunteers will be in our village office daily (Mon, Tues, & Thur) from 9:00 am to 11am and Wednesday afternoons from 4 to 6 pm starting April 1.

Trees removed from the lake. Four trees have been removed from Tecumseh. This was a two day process to pull them out of the lake and load in a dump trailer for removal. Contact the village office if you have a tree to remove. We will put a schedule together to accomplish this task. We do not guarantee it will all be completed this year.

Goose egg addling permit has been requested. Please contact me if you would like a copy of the permit to addle your nest of eggs. If you want help, please call us with the location of your nest.

Please STOP dumping branches, yard waste and trash at the Chippewa property. The total spent for Darke County and Best Way to haul debris away was \$4854. This project is completed. Plans to make a parking area for boat access are underway. Chipping to be done twice a year to eliminate this problem. Please contact the village office for a designated time for chipping, if needed.
