Village council plans to have Brice attend our monthly council meetings every other month going forward. Residents are encouraged to attend, watch the live stream, or send in questions prior to the meeting for review. Quarterly billing starts this second quarter for all homeowners in our village. Bills will be coming from Darke County. The rate will be \$45/quarter. FAQ sheets will be sent out to village residents soon.

Chipping will begin soon. We are aiming for the week of May 25th. Please have branch piles in piles that are easy to handle. If you want to have volunteers ready to assist, that would be a great help.

Daily Fishing Passes can be easily purchased at the village office, Brewer's Gatehouse, on our <u>villageofwaynelakes.com</u> website and our The Village of Wayne Lakes Facebook page. Please share with your friends!! The village has collected \$8,037 so far this year!!

Council did a first reading of our new Junk Vehicle Ordinance. The solicitor for our village recommended a new version to keep current with neighboring villages. We are currently making revisions. One revision is to allow residents 30 days to make arrangements for a junk vehicle.

Please STOP from dumping branches, yard waste and trash at the Chippewa property. Council approved \$2500 for Darke County to begin the cleanup of this property.

Two applications have been submitted for grants. CDBG grant application for Cucumber drainpipe project, with a 10% match needed. Community Development grant for Darke County Parks to purchase the Hooked-on Fishing area near Iroquois lake, with a 50% match needed. (cont'd on page 2)
