from the Mayor's desk -

Bob Tuco has resigned from Council, effective the end of the October Council meeting. Bob has served the Village of Wayne Lakes in many capacities over many years. Thank you, Bob. You will be missed at the front of the room, and we wish you happy days — enjoy fishing!

The currently available Council seat with a two-year term can be appointed by Council at the November meeting. For anyone in the Village interested, call the Village Office, 937-459-4111, before November 10 - leave your name/address for consideration and attend the November 11 Council meeting. A new President of Council will be elected at the November meeting.

Reminder that at the January 2020 Council meeting, two Council seats will be available (due to no November election candidates) for appointment by Council for the upcoming 4-year terms for each seat. Anyone who has interest to be appointed to Council should attend the January meeting. At the January meeting, the President of Council will serve also as acting Mayor (due to no November election candidates).

A few words about the Neave Township Transfer Station — The Township Trustees have shared that the Transfer Station could be closing at some point, something they have discussed for the past few years. Neave Township apparently is the only township in Darke County, perhaps in the entire state of Ohio, that provides a place for all township residents to take trash without charging per use. The money used by the Township to cover the approximately \$30K annual cost of running the Transfer Station comes from the Township's general fund (property taxes).

The Village has for many years paid monthly payments (additional tax-payer dollars) directly to the Township, payments (currently \$540/month) that had been understood recently by many were to allow Village residents to use the Transfer Station. However, all properties in the Township including in Wayne Lakes are assessed the same way for property owner's tax dollars that go into the Township's general fund (confirmed with the County Auditor), and so all residents in the Township including those in the Village have the same access to the Transfer Station. The Trustees have said that whether or not the Village continues to make the additional payments would have no bearing on their decision to leave open or to close the Transfer Station. Council is considering to stop making the additional payments to the Township (the Village is not bound by contract to pay), but **Council wants to hear from you**. Please contact a current Council member before November 10th to discuss discontinuing the additional payments to the Township and Village options if/when the Transfer Station is closed.

Council has approved a contract agreement to purchase the 1052 Main Drive property currently being used in part for the Village Office. The 10-year Land Contract agreement between the Village and the property owners is scheduled to be signed before the end of October. Obtaining this property will provide the Village with a Wayne Lakes Village Administrative Building for the first time. The property also affords the Village additional garage and storage space and has potential for many uses in the future. Contact a current Council member if you have questions.
