We lost a Wayne Lake resident that gave back to the village to make it a better place. Marilyn Fornshil passed away on September 22, 2022. She was surrounded by her loving family. She was a Lady of the lakes member back in the day. Marilyn attended village activities when she could. She made visits and phone calls to the office to make sure she kept in touch with me. She enjoyed fishing, volunteering, basketball, spoiling her grandchildren, spending time with her family and spreading love and cheer.

Brice with Access Engineering and the Wayne Lakes Sewer committee continue to work on the upcoming project. The bid has been accepted. Village council has voted to allow me as the Mayor of the village to enter into a contract for the new sanitary sewer system project as soon as all contingencies are fulfilled. We are still awaiting funds from the Ohio Development Services Agency for the Community Development Block Grant funds, the Ohio EPA gives final approval of principal forgiveness and loan funds through Water Pollution Control Loan Funds and all funding documents have been duly signed and executed, and all additional project funding is approved by the Ohio Water Development Authority, the Ohio Public Works Commission, and the H2Ohio Program.

Work Agreements. The Wayne Lakes Sewer Committee is asking all residents to please assist in getting these signed as soon as possible. A notary is provided for the village residents to aid in this process. Watch for the signs posted outside the village office indicating open office hours to complete this paperwork. Office 937-459-4111.

Leaf dumpsters are parked near the beach parking lot and Pontiac Lake for all of our residents use. Branches that have fallen on your property may also be put in the dumpsters for removal from our village.

Rumpke has contacted the village due to problems with low hanging branches on trees near our roadways. 28 Residents will be receiving letters due to trees needing trimmed. Rumpke requires that trees have 15 feet of clearance enabling their trucks to pass through the village roadways. This will ensure that your service is not disrupted. Thank you for your quick attention to this matter.

Resolution 2022-07-11-001 has been passed regarding Noxious Weeds in the village. Letters will go out to homes that need mowed and trimmed. Please trim bushes and weeds on your property that are near the road.

Poplar Lane The cost to fix is currently \$24,990.00. This project is scheduled to begin in spring 2023.
