

## And Now, What Do I do?

I was reading a message written by someone I know and she asked a question about a situation in which she felt uncomfortable, hopeless, and in need of an immediate plan. She ended the message by saying: “What Do I Do?” I could tell by her written words that she felt lost, alone, and without a direction to take — “Now What?”

My Answer to the “And Now What?” Moments:

- ◆ The LORD is not a man so, He Cannot Lie. (Whatever He has promised us He will do and whatever our needs are He will fulfil. (Numbers 23:19, para)
- ◆ The Lord is not human so He can only speak what is Truth. He is all powerful and does not make mistakes like we do. He is dependable and already in each of our futures.
- ◆ The LORD has promised that He will not leave us (Hebrews 11:5, para). He even added, if we make our beds in hell, He would still be there with us. (Psalms 139:8, para)

We can depend on Jehovah Shammah whose Spirit resides within us and wants to direct our paths in His Steps, His Plan, and His Purpose.

Finally, the Answer to the: “And Now What Moment” is:

“Now Faith” is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. By *Faith* we understand that the worlds were framed by the WORD of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible”. (Hebrews 11 1,3)NKJV
