We are running a serious congressional campaign, not an internet comment section. We expect volunteers to engage with the public in a manner that reflects maturity, professionalism, integrity, and respect for others, even when disagreements occur.

The Eric Foreman for Congress campaign reserves the right to remove, suspend, or restrict any volunteer, supporter, staff member whose actions are inconsistent with the values, expectations, and standards of the campaign.
