#### **Architectural Report**

- Management followed up with Volt Electric for their proposal to locate and repair the nicked electrical
  line for the street lighting in the 3500 court. Management also requested proposals from other vendors
  due to the lack of response from Volt. Management will investigate temporary lighting for this area and
  the entry to the clubhouse.
- Management provided the board with a proposal from Construction Concepts for snow removal.
   Construction Concepts confirmed that their price for snow removal this coming season will remain at the same rate as last year. Tamika Hill motioned to accept Construction Concepts' proposal. Harold Gause seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
- Management provided for the board's review a proposal from Barry Roofing to conduct preventative roof maintenance on all roofs. The roofs have not undergone full inspection and completion of minor repairs. Harold Gause motioned to accept the proposal from Barry Roofing. Gail Drish-Smith seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
