

# **Arrival**



## **Address**



- Our condo address is 59 Haynesville Ave Unit 8, Conway NH 02453
- Off of Route 113 (which is East Main Street) take VFW Street, Haynesville Ave islocated off of VFW Street
  - There are three buildings in the condo complex (labeled above) with three separate parking lots
  - When you turn onto Haynesville Ave, our building is after the second lamp post on the left (condo building 2 above)
- We are the second to last unit (Unit 8) all the way to the right of the complex (orange arrow above) when you pull into the parking lot
- As a reminder check-in is at 4 pm on the day that your booking begins

#### **Parking**

- You can park one car right in the front of the door (we only have one spot in front of the condo)
- All additional vehicles can be parked on the other side (right) of the parking lot
- If snow is expected please park on the far side of the parking lot to allow the plow to clear the buildings front parking area first, once the plow has come through you should move cars to the cleared area to allow clearing of the far side of the lot.

## **Entry**



- The front door has an electronic lock for easy key-less entry
- To use:
  - 1. Enter the numbers we provided to you to unlock it followed by the "LOCK" button this is your personal code and will expire after you check-out
  - 2. Hitting just the "LOCK" button when it is unlocked, locks it
  - 3. **CAUTION:** Do not lock the door knob from the inside, only use the above deadbolt. If you accidentally lock yourself out in this manner please contact us immediately.
- The back-slider door has a wooden stick to lock it and a manual door lock

## Heat and A/C

All rooms have electric baseboards. There is a gas fireplace/stove and a window A/C unit installed seasonally in each room.

- Instructions for the electric baseboards:
  - There are thermostats in all bedrooms, the bathroom, and the living room to control the electric baseboards.
- Instructions for the fireplace:
  - o The remote is on the coffee table. When you use it, it helps to face the remote right at the unit. After a second the flame should ignite. This unit is way more effective than the electric baseboards at heating up the room, we recommend you use it first.

# **During your Stay**



## Kitchen

- We provide all the basic utensils you need to cook your own meals during your stay:
   pots, pans, cooking oil, spices...explore and you will find what you need
- There is a combo, single cup Keurig style machine plus coffee pot and coffee filters if you want to bring/buy your own coffee or K-cups
- Groceries There is a Shaw's, Super Walmart, and Hannaford about a 10-minute drive away for food supplies. These supermarkets also sell beer and wine (we have a corkscrew and bottle opener in the kitchen).
  - o There is also a NH State Liquor & Wine Outlet 5 minutes away
    - Address: 234 White Mtn Hwy Suite 9. Conway, NH 03818
- We may leave a few nonperishable items in the cupboards or freezer. We'd really appreciate them still being there when next we visit.

## **Grill (seasonal)**

- Please feel free to use the propane grill off the back deck
- Please keep the grill on the ground and do not move onto the deck
- Grilling utensils are located in a black case in an upper cabinet
- A fire extinguisher and fire blanket are located under the kitchen sink please make sure you locate it *before* you start grilling in case it was moved by another guest or our cleaning staff and you can't find it when you need it!

## **Bedding/Towels**

- All rooms have clean bedding and towels
- Pillows and blankets for the pull-out daybed can be found in the 3 drawers of the daybed This bed extends to a king size by pulling out the front like a large drawer. It's a bit of a job to slide it in and out and requires two people because the slats can get stuck on the frame if it's extended out too far. Please don't force it shut. If you pull it out and can't get it closed with gentle pressure just leave it open and we'll take care of it. An easier option for creating two twin beds from the daybed is to take one of the two stacked twin mattresses and place it on the floor.

#### Water

- We have a 40-gallon hot water tank. This is enough to take a number of showers in a row, however if you run out of hot water, just give it a little bit of time to heat back up!
- Please only flush toilet paper down the toilet. Wipes, feminine products, etc should be put in the trash can.

## **TV/Internet**

- We do not have cable, but we do have a Roku Smart TV in the living room and Amazon Firesticks on all 4 TV's. Please do not purchase or rent content via any of my logged in accounts!
- Bedroom TVs: The firesticks are the primary device on all three bedroom TV's. The Fire Stick remote controls also power on the TV's so that's the only remote you should need. The 3<sup>rd</sup> floor bunkroom TV has adult content restricted on Netflix.
- Living Room TV is a Roku smart TV. You can login into your own Netflix account there via the main screen. Please remember to log- out of your account prior to leaving! Use the Roku remote to turn it on and navigate to apps. You can access the Amazon Fire Stick via HDMI3. Once there use the Amazon Fire Stick remote to navigate. I have left my Amazon Video, Netflix and Disney + accounts logged in for your convenience. Please use the guest accounts for viewing where applicable.
- How to log-in to your account:
  - Netflix
    - Turn on the TV via Roku remote
    - Select the Netflix app
    - Select Sign In. If you do not see Sign In, select Yes on the Are you a member of Netflix? screen. If you are not yet a member, set up your membership online.
    - Enter your Netflix email address and password.
    - Select Sign In

## **Supplies/Amenities**

- A hairdryer is located under the sink in the bathroom
- Shampoo and conditioner are provided in the shower for your convenience, but feel free to use your own if you prefer
- Extra toilet paper is located under the bathroom sink and on top of the washing machine
- Trash bags, paper towels, cleaning supplies, and dishwasher detergent is located under the kitchen sink or the lower cabinet to the right of the sink
- There are board games, puzzles and cards located in the cabinet under the TV. Feel free to use! We appreciate you leaving them as you found them.
- There is a fire extinguisher under the kitchen sink as well as a fire blanket. There is an emergency window fire ladder on the third floor stored in a box in the wicker trunk.
- You will notice the entryway closet door is locked, as well as the under-eave storage doors on the second and third floor. These are private storage closets where we keep our personal items.

## Laundry

- If you need to do laundry, it is in the upstairs bathroom.
- Please don't over load the machine,
   stuffing in bulky items can lead to flooding -
- There are detergent pods on top of the machine you are welcome to use They go directly in the washing machine tub before you add the clothing
- Please leave the washer door open to dry after it's been used to prevent mold

## **Rental Rules**

- No smoking
- No pets are allowed
- **No parties** only those that have rented the property are allowed on the premises.
- There is a maximum of 8 renters (max 4 adults unless otherwise agreed) permitted in the condo, please do not bringmore people than allowed.

# Departure Check-list



## As a reminder, checkout is at 11 am on the day that your booking ends

- ✓ For stays from May-September:
  - Please turn off all thermostats (each bedroom, bathroom, and one downstairs), turning counter-clockwise (or incrementing the down arrow) past 40 degrees until you can no longer turn, for all electric baseboards
  - o Please turn off the fireplace with the remote and replace on the coffee table
- ✓ For stays from October-April:
  - o Please turn off the fireplace with the remote and replace on the coffee table
  - Electric baseboards: turn all down to 50°
  - Kitchen cabinets: leave the cabinet under the sink open, so the pipes do not freeze.
     They are the same ones that were open when you got there.
- ✓ Please make sure all dishes are washed and put away or in the drying rack
- ✓ Throw away or bring with you any leftover food. Do not leave food behind in the cabinets or in the fridge.
- ✓ Please make sure to replace the grill cover and check that the propane tank is turned off.
- ✓ Strip the beds and place the sheets and towels on the floor in the bathroom.
- Ensure all windows and doors, including the sliding door, are locked. For the sliding door, please make sure the wooden stick is replaced
- Bring all trash from the kitchen and bathroom and recyclables to the dumpsters at the end of Haynesville Ave (orange arrow to the right is our condo and the green arrow is the location of the dumpsters).
  - There is one for trash and one for recyclables. Please make sure to use the right one!
  - Recyclables should NOT be in a plastic bag. Please empty the contents of the recyclables into the bin and then throw the plastic bag in the trash. The plastic clogs the recyclable machine.

- **Attitash Mountain** the lift ticket for Attitash also works at Wildcat so you can mix and match your ski weekend! They are under 20 minutes from each other

  - Pro tip: Park and start skiing at Bear Peak (one of the two peaks) for shorterlines and faster lifts!
- Wildcat Mountain a mountain with more advanced terrain and amazing views of Mount Washington

- **Bretton Woods** located near the famous Mount Washington Resort on Rt 302. This is one of the premiere family ski resorts in the area with amazing views of Mount Washington

## **Snowshoeing/Nordic Skiing**

- Ragged Mountain Cross-country ski and snowshoe rentals can be purchased at Ragged Mountain. There is an extensive, groomed network of trails behind Ragged Mountain. Please note a day pass is required to access these trails and they are monitored.

- Whittaker Woods The network of trails at Ragged Mountain connects all the way to Whittaker Woods. There are no rentals at this location. Please note a day pass is required to access these trails and they are monitored. Day passes can be purchased at Ragged Mountain or the Whittaker Lodge when staffed.

- **Echo Lake State Park** A nice easy loop, with beautiful scenery for snow-shoeing which does not require a pass

  - Driving Time: 15 minutes

## Hiking

- Kancamangus Highway The "Kanc" starts about 5 minutes from our house. There is a Ranger Station at the beginning of the highway where you can purchase seasonal or weekend parking passes and maps. The Kanc is a beautiful drive in the summer and especially during leaf-peeping season. Keep your eyes open for moose and black bears! There are many turn-offs which feature short hikes and waterfalls including:
  - Sabbaday Falls
  - Champney Falls
  - Lower Falls
- **Whittaker Woods** A network of walking trails in North Conway with a mixture of flat terrain and small inclines. Can also use mountain bikes to explore the trails.
  - Address: 2820 White Mountain Hwy, North Conway, NH 03860
  - Driving Time: 14 minutes
  - A day pass is required which can be purchased at the Whittaker lodge (when staffed) or Ragged Mountain (302 279, NH-16, Intervale, NH 03845)
- **Diana's Bath** An easy hike to a series of waterfalls and pools. Bring your towel and swim suit for a cold but refreshing dip in one of the pools.
  - o Address: 3725 West Side Rd, Bartlett, NH 03812
  - Driving Time: 17 minutes
- **Flume Gorge** An 800-foot natural gorge. Entrance fee required.
  - Address: 852 Daniel Webster Hwy, Lincoln, NH 03251
  - Driving Time: 1 hour
- Lost River Gorge & Boulder Canyons Forged by the forces of water, wind, and time. Kids will love scrambling through the caves. Entrance fee required.
  - o Address: 1712 Lost River Rd, North Woodstock, NH 03262
  - Driving Time: 1 hour 5 minutes
- **Black Cap Mountain** (easy-moderate) A hiking and biking trail within Green Hills Preserve. It is 5.7 miles long, good for all skill levels, and boasts great views on top

- Address: Trailhead is off of Hurricane Mountain Road, Intervale, NH (steep, bumpy road, closed during the winter)
- o <u>Driving Time</u>: 24 minutes
- Cathedral Ledge and White Horse Ledge (moderate) Well-known rock-climbing spots with several hiking options as well. Can access via the Bryce Path, which splits off from the Echo Lake trail. The top of Cathedral Ledge is 1.2 miles from the beginning of Bryce Path, and White Horse Ledge trail forms a 4.2-mile loop from the Bryce Path. For those wishing to avoid the climb up from Echo Lake, the Cathedral Ledge Road offers a nice alternative.

  - Driving Time: 15 minutes
- Our Favorite, more strenuous hikes:
  - Arethusa Falls and Frankenstein Trail (difficult): 4.2 mile round-trip that takes you past a gorgeous waterfall and to a great viewpoint
  - Mount Kearsage (difficult): 5.7 mile round-trip that takes you to a fire tower with
     360 degree views of the valley. Wear bug spray!
  - Mount Chocorua (difficult): Take the Champney Falls trail (6.6 miles) off the Kancamangus or the Piper Trail (9 miles) which is located in the town of Chocorua south of Conway on Rt 16. This hike takes about 5-7 hours round-trip depending on your ability level. You are rewarded with 360° views on the treeless summit.
  - For hikers looking for a real challenge, New Hampshire is home to 48 4000 footers, almost all are easily accessible from our condo including Mt. Washington and the other Presidentials. Many are located off the Kanc.
- \*\*Please note the parking lots for many of these hikes require a fee which must be paid in cash at the trail entrance, unless you purchase a long-term pass at the Ranger Station.

## **Swimming/Water Sports**

- Echo Lake State Park Open in the summer for picnics and swimming.
