EDITOR'S NOTES

Subsequent to John McCrary's resignation as editor of the SCCA NEWS two people tried and failed to assume this duty. This is, perhaps, a testament to the difficulty involved in publishing a booklet using nonprofessional, volunteer help. It makes the fine job done by John, and Lee Hyder before him, that much more impressive. I had intended to publish the current issue of the SCCA NEWS several weeks ago. However, I was forced to delay publication until arrangements could be completed for the South Carolina Closed Championships. Don Lemaster ran into problems with the person at the Seibels-Bruce Bldg. in charge of letting us use their facility. He was on jury duty for two weeks during which time he would not return Don's calls, and when Don finally got an answer it was "no." For this reason, the tournament will be held at the Tremont Motor Inn, a site used in a few previous championships. My goals for the SCCA NEWS are threefold. First, to get back to a regular publication schedule. I intend to publish during the months of January, May, and September. Second, to get this magazine back on a sound financial footing. To this end I will not use a professional typist (unless, of course, one volunteers). We will sacrifice the magazine's appearance, but at least we should be able to pay our bills.

Third, to get more people involved as contributors. For this reason I have eliminated the post of Games Editor and will use several persons to annotate games. My thanks to Charles Braun for carrying this burden alone for these many years. I would also ask that each club president appoint someone to send me a summary of club activities for each four month period prior to publication. Thus, each club will have space set aside each issue if it so desires. By the way, I would like for each club to send me a note about meeting times, places, etc. I will compile a list for future publication. Lastly, I have created the job of Associate Editor. This role is intended to be filled by someone that will make sure that the Editor stays on-task (and, hopefully, prevent Editor burn-out). Mickey Bush has agreed to serve in this capacity. I hope to see many of you at the state championship.
