TEAM MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

There is a \$150 annual dues for team members. This fee has been reduced to \$50 for the 2021/2022 inaugural year. These dues are required to keep members fully invested in the program. Members who do not stay active will be removed from the team and dues will not be refunded.

Team members are required to attend 4 or more of the following. Each event the member attends will earn points. These points can be traded at the end of the members term for logo gear, tack, or team buckle.
