

How to Install Mods in the Sims 4 on Windows

Equipment

- PC with at least 4GB of RAM and internet access.

Finding Mods

There are numerous websites where creators post their mod creations for different games.

- **Mod The Sims**

One of the largest collection of free mods for *The Sims 2*, *3*, and *4*.

- **The Sims Resource (TSR)**

The largest and longest-running source of free to download mods for *The Sims*. This website also has a paid membership options which grants access to specific features.

- **CurseForge**

A newer source for *The Sims 4* mods that neatly organizes and lists the most recent mods by popular creators.

Installing Mods

Note: In order to install mods in *The Sims 4*, you will need to already have *The Sims 4* game downloaded onto your PC or Mac.

1. Download your Mod or CC of choice. (Unzip the download, if it's a .rar or .zip file.)

2. Click on the File Explorer  icon located either on your desktop or Start menu.

3. Locate and open the file named "This PC."

4. Select the file titled "Documents."

5. Select the file named "Electronic Arts." From there, select "The Sims4" file.

6. Select the file called "Mods."

7. *Note:* If you do not see a folder called “Mods” you can create your own within the same location.
8. Open *The Sims 4*.
9. Open the Options, and then select the “Game Options” tab.
10. Select the “Other” tab.
11. Make sure “enable custom content and mods” is checked.
12. Relaunch *The Sims 4*.
