

Bylaws of Table Tennis Western Sydney

Bylaw 1: Suspension of Members from Play and Venue Access

- 1.1 The Committee shall have the authority to suspend a member from participating in the Table Tennis Western Sydney competition if the member demonstrates repeated instances of poor conduct and has received a formal warning from the Committee.
- 1.2 A suspension imposed under this bylaw shall not revoke the member's status as part of the association unless explicitly determined by the Committee.
- 1.3 The Committee may impose a suspension while awaiting the resolution of an appeal concerning the member's potential suspension from the association.

Bylaw 2: Conducting a committee meeting

- 2.1 The committee may transact its business in person or by the circulation of papers, including by electronic means such as email, among all committee members.
- 2.2 If the committee transacts business by the circulation of papers by electronic means such as email, a written resolution, approved in writing by a majority of committee members, is taken to be a decision of the committee made at a meeting of the committee.
- 2.3 The committee may transact its business at a meeting at which 1 or more committee members participate by telephone or other electronic means, provided a member who speaks on a matter can be heard by the other members, otherwise all correspondence must be in writing.
- 2.4 The member presiding at the meeting and each other member have the same voting rights as they would have at an ordinary meeting of the committee for the purposes of: (a) the approval of a resolution under subclause (2.2), or
(b) a meeting held in accordance with subclause (2.3).
- 2.5 A resolution approved under subclause (2.2) must be recorded in the minutes of the meetings of the committee.

Bylaw 3: Priority for ordinary committee member nominations

3.1 Priority for general/ordinary committee member nominations is to be provided first to ensure at least one nominated member from each Table Tennis Western Sydney member club is elected from financial members.

3.2 Once each Table Tennis Western Sydney club has at least one member on the general committee all other general/ordinary committee positions are open for nomination and election if required.

3.3 If a club provided no nominations that reserved position will be open to all financial members of other clubs within Table Tennis Western Sydney.

3.4 Any new club will need to have their club participate in Table Tennis Western Sydney for at least 1 year and have individual members financial before they can be considered for the general/ordinary committee membership priority.

3.5 Office bearer positions are not included in this by-law.
