We have curated 2 half day sightseeing experiences in Jaipur, to take advantage of the beautiful city before or after the conference. You can attend just one half day or both as they showcase different parts of the city.



21 Nov: Morning sightseeing.

This morning, join your guide for a half-day tour of Jaipur. Visit the Amer Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with stunning Mughal and Hindu architecture. Next, explore the Panna Meena ka Kund, a centuries-old symmetrical stepwell. End at the Anokhi Museum of Hand Printing to learn about traditional block printing techniques. Return to your hotel to relax afterward.



24 Nov: Morning sightseeing.

After breakfast, join your guide for a half-day tour of Jaipur. Visit the City Palace, a stunning complex with palaces, gardens, and rare collections. Explore the nearby Jantar Mantar, an 18th-century observatory. Finish with a stroll through Jaipur's vibrant markets, famous for traditional crafts, textiles, and jewelry.
