

Delegate Brooke Grossman Legislative Scholarship Application Information Sheet for 2023-2024

Delegate Grossman is excited to offer legislative scholarships for the 2023-2024 academic year. This scholarship is awarded to students attending a college, university or trade school in Maryland. What Is a Delegate Scholarship?

Delegate Grossman's Legislative Scholarship is awarded to recognize students for their academic excellence and to help students who have financial need. The major criteria considered for the scholarship award are: **Academic achievement, community service / volunteer activities, and financial need.**

Who Is Eligible?

Students who currently live in legislative **District 2B** and who plan to attend an accredited college, university, or trade school program in Maryland for the 2023-2024 academic year will be eligible for a scholarship award.

How Do I Apply?

Use the following as a checklist to make sure you have everything necessary before mailing your application. **ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.** We do not accept electronic applications.

1. **Create a Student Login Profile** through the Maryland College Aid Processing System [MDCAPS]: <https://mdcaps.mhec.state.md.us> We cannot consider your application until you are registered.
2. **Complete the Application Form.** Please type or neatly print the information required and sign the document, including a parent / guardian signature if required.
3. **The Application Form must be mailed together with the following documents:**
 - An essay of 300-500 words** that describes **your career and academic interests.**
 - A resumé** that includes career interests, scholastic awards, work experience, and community service projects or volunteer experience.
 - An un-official transcript** from your high school for the last semester with your unweighted, cumulative GPA.
 - A copy of **the first page** of your FAFSA Student Aid Report that indicates your **EFC. PLEASE DO NOT SEND** your entire FAFSA report.
4. The completed application must be **postmarked by March 31, 2023.** Applications postmarked after that date will be considered only if there is funding available. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

You will receive a letter notifying you of your award by the end of May.
