Since this time we have been sharing a pastor, as well as various staff persons and programs. With the recent appointment of Father Vincent as our pastor, a blueprint of the parishes was presented to him. This information reflects numerous items, including the financial status of the parishes, as well as the number of individuals in the parishes, number of households, number of baptisms, number of deaths, and the average total weekend Mass attendance count. ARE YOU A PARISHIONER?
