**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S *EX PARTE* MOTION FOR ORDER
AUTHORIZING ALTERNATIVE SERVICE OF PROCESS ON
DEFENDANTS PURSUANT TO FED R. CIV. P. 4(f)(3)**

On April 17, 2024, Plaintiff Stephen Shaya filed his *Ex Parte* Motion for Order Authorizing Alternative Service of Process on Defendants Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(f)(3) (ECF No. 15). The Court has reviewed Plaintiff's Motion, Brief in Support, and the declarations and exhibits filed in support of the same, as well as the authority cited therein. The Court concludes that service pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(f)(3) by publication of the Summonses, Complaint, and this Order to the website Plaintiff's counsel caused to be created, and for which a hyperlink was included in the Service Tokens delivered into the cryptocurrency wallet addresses identified in Plaintiff's Complaint on March 22, 2024, is reasonably calculated to provide

defendants notice of this action and is not prohibited by international agreement.

Based on the foregoing,

It is hereby **ORDERED THAT** pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(f)(3), Plaintiff may effectuate service of the Summonses, Complaint, this Order, and any other documents for which service is permitted or required, by publication on the website Plaintiff's counsel caused to be created (<https://order21ag7.com/>), which hyperlink was contained in the Service Tokens Plaintiff's counsel caused to be delivered on March 22, 2024 to the cryptocurrency wallet addresses identified in Exhibit A of Plaintiff's Complaint.

It is further **ORDERED THAT** Plaintiff shall file an affidavit or declaration of service setting forth the date the Summonses, Complaint, and this Order have been published to the website Plaintiff's counsel caused to be created (<https://order21ag7.com/>), which date shall be the date on which service of process of the Summonses and Complaint was effectuated on Defendants.
