COVID TESTING: Available at Corbett Clinic, <u>Appointment Required</u> - email Patti at <u>pattialbury@abacohealthservices.com</u>.

Sewerage: Until the community septic system is replaced- minimize water going into the sewer. Flush toilets when solids are present, shorten showers and use the laundry to wash clothing.

Drinking water: Purified water available at the laundry for \$1.00 per gallon. Bring your own container to refill. Do not drink the tap water.

Laundry: Coin/token operated laundry. \$3.00 tokens available at office. Open during office hours. Use the Laundry instead of the villa washing machines.

Garbage/trash: Put your bagged trash in the back of the gardener's truck until further notice. No recycling available on island.

Gates: Gates will be locked 9pm to 7am, Except Cabott Road will be locked at 11pm to 7am. Need a key? Its available at the office, plan ahead! You **must** lock the gates after leaving & entering. After hours call 242- 817-9653 or 242-577-2022

Pool: No lifeguard on duty, swim at own risk. Children under age of 15 must be supervised by an adult owner or guest. No glass of any kind permitted in pool area. Obey all posted pool regulations.

Groceries: Maxwell's and Abaco Grocery are fully stocked. Plan to do all your grocery shopping in Marsh Harbour. G & M Food Store on SC Bootle Hwy. near where Touch of Class was. Meat and produce coming.

Convenience store: Located where it's always been -across the road, to the left in the blue plaza. They have ice available.

Gas: Available at the gas dock (close at 4pm) which is to the south of the roundabout by the old power plant. Rubis is also on the main highway (closed at 6pm) in the Sand Banks Area

Wine and Spirits: We hear one is coming soon to central Treasure Cay. But for now, I'd pick it up in Marsh Harbour. There is a nice one next to Abaco Grocer's.

Florence's Bakery (7am-5pm) in the blue plaza across the road to the left. Terry from creative serves breakfast and will cook to order 357-6620. Bahama Beach Club is open 12pm until, serving Lunch & Dinner

Wifi: Visit Aliv in Marsh Harbour (Resilience Square) for Internet Services. Or purchase an Aliv puck (hotspot) from Aliv They are \$90 per month. They hold a charge for 4-5 hours and are powerful enough to stream TV shows and movies.
