Drinking water: Purified water available at the laundry for \$1.00 per gallon. Bring your own container to refill (located in the villa). Do not drink the tap water, as it is high in chlorine. It is safe for food prep.

Laundry: Coin/token operated laundry. \$3.00 tokens available at the office. Please bring your own soap.

Garbage/trash: Put your bagged (sealed plastic bags only) trash in the back of the gardener's truck until further notice. Break down all boxes. No recycling available on the island. Please be sure to not place loose garbage in the truck. Please do not use the empty receptacle in the ground at the back of your villa.

Road Gates: June to October the gates will be locked 10 pm to 6am. Need a key? It's available at the office; plan ahead! You **must** lock the gates after leaving & entering. After hours call 559-9012 or 242-817-9653 or 242-577-2022

Pool: No lifeguard on duty; swim at your own risk. Children under age 15 must be supervised by an adult owner or guest. No glass of any kind permitted in the pool area. Obey all posted pool regulations. Pool is heated.

Groceries: Maxwell's and Abaco Grocery are fully stocked. Plan to do all your grocery shopping in Marsh Harbour. Local shops have limited inventory.

Convenience store: It is located where it's always been - across the road, to the left in the blue plaza. They have ice available. Please go to google to see the items that they stock.

Kulas Mart: Is located on the entrance to Treasure. If coming from Marsh Harbour and after turning off S.C. Bootle Highway, it is located on your immediate left. If you are coming from Treasure Cay, it's on your right just before turning on the highway. It has more of a variety compared to the convenience store that is located across the street.

Banking: USD cash is on par with the Bahamian dollar and is widely accepted in the Bahamas. Credit cards are widely accepted at stores. There is no ATM machine nearby, therefore please stop at an ATM in Marsh before heading to Treasure Cay.

Gas: Available at the gas dock in Treasure Cay (closes at 4pm) which is to the south of the roundabout by the old power plant. Rubis gas is also on the main highway (closed at 6pm) on the way to Marsh Harbour.

Wine and Spirits: There is a small liquor store in Treasure Cay and on the Bootle Highway on the way to Marsh Harbour. Best to shop in Marsh Harbour before heading to Treasure.
