2019 Student Teacher Scholarship Application

The NASTSE Student Teacher Scholarship will be awarded to a student majoring in Skilled and Technical Sciences Education and plans to student teach in Nebraska during the Fall 2019 or Spring 2020 school terms. The scholarship is intended to assist in financial support while relocating from college to student teaching. Students attending Wayne State College or the University of Nebraska-Lincoln are eligible for this scholarship.

The scholarship will be awarded at the annual Nebraska Career Education Conference, held annually in Kearney during the first week of June. The winner will be notified at least one month in advance of the conference and is expected to attend the conference to accept the award. The amount of the award will be up to \$400.00.

- Description of why you are planning to teach Industrial Technology Education
