MAINTENANCE TIPS

CLEANING THE TOP

On all tops, you may use a soft brush and a mild dishwashing detergent. Allow the top to dry thoroughly before putting it back down. Do not use bleach as it will rot the threads.

RUBBER SEALS

Every six months, spray all the rubber seals that contact the windows, as well as those that meet across the front of the car with a pure silicone spray, available at your local hardware store or automotive parts retailer.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. If the latch hook does not reach, power top forward slightly:
Do not unscrew latch hook to gain "reach." The hook could come loose when driving which could cause the top to be caught by the wind.
2. If the boot does not fit properly and/or the top will not lower fully:
Check to see if any items are stored or haven't fallen into the well area.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

1. When raising or lowering the top, keep hands away from the "scissoring action" hinge part of the side roof rail or any of the top linkage. These moving parts could cause injury to you.
2. To avoid any damage to the automobile, convertible top and/or rear window, do not operate the top while the vehicle is in motion. Make certain the top is latched to the windshield header prior to driving the vehicle.
3. Do not use automatic car wash facilities! They may cause damage to the top and could possibly cause leakage to occur.
4. When the top structure is down, do not sit on the top structure that is located behind the rear seat. This could result in damage to the top structure.

SAFETY DISCLAIMER

Side Curtain Airbags

The Dodge Challenger has been equipped with side curtain airbags. These airbags have been permanently removed to facilitate the top structure mechanism and are no longer available.

TOP OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

LOWERING PROCEDURE

1. Always run the car's engine when operating the top to ensure full voltage to the top motor.
If the engine is not running, (and battery is low), the voltage drop creates an amperage draw that may damage the top and/or window motors.
2. Unlatch both latches at the windshield corners.
3. Manually, raise the top a few inches to verify that both latches are free and then close the latches.
4. Lower the rear quarter windows.
5. Push the bottom side of the top switch (under the dash to the left of the steering column).
6. Install the convertible boot.

RAISING PROCEDURE

1. Always run the car's engine when operating the top to ensure full voltage to the top motor.
If the engine is not running, (and battery is low), the voltage drop creates an amperage draw that may damage the top and/or window motors.
2. Remove boot if it has been installed.
3. Push the top side of the switch, (under the dash to the left of the steering column), until the top nears the windshield.
4. Manually, pull down the top toward the windshield and fasten both latches. It may be necessary to slightly motor the top forward so that the latch hook can reach the hole.
5. After the latches have been secured, raise the rear quarter glass.
