INTERNATIONAL CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP (ICF)

The Lord has been faithful as he has allowed us to see many new families join our church and begin to grow and disciple others. Recently we held our first annual family retreat weekend. We spent time reflecting on God's goodness and how we are blessed to be a blessing! Out of this retreat new Bible study groups were formed and have continued to grow over the last few months. These groups included a men's group, women's group and several dedicated prayer groups.



In November we launched several new intensive discipleship groups including an intensive 10 week course called "Training Leaders for Christ" (TLC). We had our first group complete the first 10 weeks and now they are each taking a group through the first session as they themselves go through the 2nd 10 week session. Our hope is that leaders will continue to multiply and disciple others!

On Sundays after church we have several groups which include youth, children and adults that meet for 5 week sessions. These sessions focus on equipping others to share their faith and disciple others! Going forward we plan to provide topical units of study which will help equip participants as they grow in Christ and navigate through their own journey of faith!

ROSSLYN ACADEMY

It has been a busy semester at school. We are very thankful that COVID numbers have steadily declined and we have been able to continue learning in-person this year! Due to the lifting of some restrictions, we have been able to resume some extra curricular activities and after school programs such as sports, drama, and cultural field studies trips.

Cultural Field Studies (CFS)

Rosslyn Academy uses these CFS trips to help students develop a better understanding of different cultures throughout Kenya. These annual trips begin at the 5th grade level where students typically go on a 2 day trip and by High School students will go for 3-4 days to live and work amongst different people groups. It is truly an amazing learning experience and it definitely gives the students a new perspective on life!



This year, I was part of the 8th grade CFS as we visited a remote area known as Suswa. Here, we camped for two nights, experienced the Maasai culture that lives on the outer rim of a volcano in the Rift Valley known as Mt Suswa, We helped build a water catchment system for the local village who's only source of water was from a natural steam vent or crack in the earth. The catchment system was designed to capture steam and retain the water droplets in a holding tank. Villagers would walk miles and miles with their donkeys to collect their allotted amount each week.



OTHER MINISTRY

We continue to partner with various ministry teams throughout Kenya and Tanzania. We have been able to offer trainings for local pastors and leaders as we concentrate on sharing the gospel and discipling new believers!



Food Distributions

Through your giving and partnerships we have been able to help support several ongoing food distribution programs in areas of the country where people have been devastated by drought. During these distributions we have been able to share the Gospel and as a result people have come to saving faith in Jesus Christ!



Village School Partnership

We have been able to provide much needed supplies and books to a local school within these villages. The needs are much greater than we can meet at this time, but we will continue to partner with them as they seek to offer early learning to these beautiful children. Our prayer is that these gifts will continually remind them of God's love and faithfulness!
