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WHEN CALLING 999 SPEAK CLEARLY AND CALMLY AND TELL THEM THE FOLLOWING;

You need an ambulance.

The location; 3G pitch, The Priory School, Hitchin

what3words headsets. balanced. packages

What has happened, in as much detail as possible.

Age and gender of casualty.

The status of the casualty, is he/she breathing?

Is CPR being administered?

Give them you name and number.

Stay on the line until instructed otherwise.

Listen carefully the operator's instructions.

Keep calm, clear and control the scene.

Ask someone to call 999 and ask for an ambulance.

Ask someone to fetch the defibrillator.

Clear the casualty's airways, two fingers under the chin and tilt head back

Pinch casualty's nose, for an adult give two initial rescue breaths.

Start cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) Give 30 compressions followed by 2 breaths. "Stayin' Alive"

Repeat CPR (30:2) until help arrives.

No signs of life? As soon as the defibrillator arrives turn it on and follow verbal instructions from device.
