## Zero Waste Team Education

The City of Phoenix has goals to reach 50% waste diversion by 2030 and zero waste by 2050, consistent with the goals set by the City's Climate Action Plan. To reach these goals, Phoenix seeks to develop the circular economy and maximize recycling and reuse efforts to further divert resources away from the landfill. Our efforts will lessen environmental impacts by reducing the amount of greenhouse gases entering the atmosphere, while creating healthier communities, and spurring economic activity.

In order to reach the city's zero waste goal by 2050, the Zero Waste team provides education and community outreach to teach the community about waste diversion. These methods include group tours of the city's North Gateway Transfer Station and Materials Recovery Facility (MRF), educational presentations to schools, neighborhood and community meetings and hosting informational booths at community events.

## Southwest Airlines - March 13th



# Sperry now standard in Citation

Sperry autopilot and instruments are now standard on the Cessna Citation.

Beginning with Aircraft No. 275, due off the line in Wichita in July, standard factory equipment will include the new SPZ-500 autopilot, air data computer, SPI-80 or 81 flight director instrument system, V/NAV computer, and servoed barometric altimeter. A Sperry radio altimeter is a factory installed option.

Options for the co-pilot's side involve several combinations of STARS four-inch instruments including the GH-14 gyro horizon with flight director bars, HZ-454 single-cue ADI, and RD-444 HSI.

The new SPI-81 five-inch instrument system includes Sperry's first five-inch single cue ADI, the

AD-600. With the cross-pointer AD-300, the system is the SPI-80. Cessna offers a choice of either AD-600 or AD-300 at the same price. A new HSI, the RD-600, is common to both systems.

A common flight director/autopilot computer, the Z-500, mixes data from air data computer, vertical, directional, and rate gyros (all Sperry), and nav radio/DME to provide altitude pre-select, course tracking, vertical speed and Mach hold functions. With the V/NAV computer it allows selection of computed vertical flight path.

Sperry Flight Systems will take delivery of Aircraft No. 275, to be used for flight demonstrations and future development work.

The Desert Botanical Garden has free admission on the second Tuesday of the month from the hours of 8-6 PM. The garden and the neighboring Phoenix Zoo are accessible from the bus line; however, not by the light rail.

Best advice is to check the bus schedule, as times and bus numbers are subject to change.

Desert Botanical Garden is a 140-acre botanical garden located in Papago Park, at 1201 N. Galvin Parkway in Phoenix, <u>Central Arizona</u>.

Founded by the Arizona Cactus and Native Flora Society in 1937 and established at this site in 1939, the garden now has more than 50,000 plants, in more than 4,000 taxa, one-third of which are native to the area, including 379 species, which are rare, threatened or endangered.

All guests (members or general admission guests) are required to register and have a timedentry ticket prior to entry to the Garden.


