

The College of Veterinary Medicine at Midwestern Glendale Campus will host an open house on Saturday, October 27, 2018 from 9:00am to 2:00pm. Everyone from pet owners to ranchers to aspiring veterinarians is welcome to attend with their families to see the future of animal healthcare in Arizona. Expert faculty and veterinary students will be on hand to answer questions and showcase the College's veterinary clinics and

facilities. Over 20 informative booths and exhibits will be available for the public.

Attendees will be treated to facility tours of the state-of-the-art Companion Animal Clinic, Equine and Bovine Center, and Diagnostic Pathology Center. Families will be able to interact with animals, see a simulated cow birth, and discover how pathology and forensics can help deter animal abuse and treat disease, and much more.



This is a private tour for Sperry, Honeywell and Garrett clubs. Tours are approximately 2 hours and include the historic Castle's main floor and basement, extensive grounds and cactus gardens surrounding the Castle. Most of the tour is outside riding a tram so dress warm. The tour starts at 10 am and the grounds are cool. The tour is wheel chair accessible but no electric scooters are allowed. 



CRIME PREVENTION BULLETIN

Glendale Police Department

The Glendale Police Department would like to assist you in preventing auto thefts and thefts from vehicles in your area. Below is a list of auto-theft and theft-from-vehicle prevention tips that can assist you in reducing your chances of becoming a crime victim.

- Always keep the doors locked and the windows closed.
- Never store valuables (purses, computers, CD's, change, etc) in your car, especially in plain view.
- · Always park in well-lit areas.
- Use an auto-theft deterrent device such as wheel locks (e.g. the Club), car alarms, steering wheel column collars, kill switches, and starter interrupt devices.
- Install a locking gas cap to prevent gas thefts and limit a thief's driving range to one tank.
- Install A catalytic converter anti-theft device
- Never keep your title, personal identification, or credit cards in your car.
- Know your license plate number and have your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) handy in your personal records.
- Report suspicious individuals loitering around vehicles and checking car doors to the Glendale Police Department's non-emergency number (623) 930-3000 and report any theft as soon as it occurs.
- If you see a crime in progress call 9-1-1 immediately.
