#### Everyone remembers Ada,



Ada Eagar Wallace
Gelling was born 93
years ago in St John's,
AZ, in her parents'
home. Her dad was a
cowboy and an
Apache county
Sherriff. Her Mom
taught Indian
children on the
reservation in

Sanders, AZ. Her grand-parents settled the town of Eagar, AZ. There were 3 girls and 2 boys; Ada was the youngest. Her brother Ed was in the CIA and head of the US Border Patrol Academy. He was on the TV show "To Tell the Truth" with Peggy Cass, Tom Poston and Kitty Carlisle trying to figure out who the real John Edward Eagar was?

After graduating HS, Ada lived in a dorm at Arizona teachers College (now ASU). World War II was going on, so she ended up in Tucson working at Consolidated Vultee riveting on B24's then moved to downtown Phoenix. She remembers living in a boarding house and traveling by Streetcar to the FOX Theater and shops.

Working in Goodyear at Goodyear
Aircraft was the next step for Ada after
losing her husband to brain cancer. An
article in the Republic shows Ada
Wallace riveting on an airplane wing, and
in the Balloon room where she worked
before riveting on Blimps for the Navy.







In 1957, Ada was hired in at Sperry as the 389<sup>th</sup> person and with a recommend from Morris Udall (1976 Candidate for US President). Sperry had a rule if you worked there you couldn't have a relative working there too. She spotted a woman whom she knew was married to her cousin. Ted Thall told her to keep her month shut – now they ship everything to other countries!

Also, before "Women's Lib" women had to get work, but men could stand around taking. It was important for her to be a tough inspector, because someone's safety was involved, but she was well liked.

One day through a technician was giving her a bad time and she told him, "YOU CAN GO SIT AND SPIN". She was talking about her decision. It got around the Sperry people asking she did really say that – she never even cursed. It is a family joke now!

After 30 years inspecting many things and parts for F16 flight systems, the Apollo mission to the moon and then meeting astronauts Fred Haise and Ron Evans... Ada Retired in 1987



On her 87<sup>th</sup> Birthday on July 14, 2012; a flag was flown all day at the US Capital in Washington D.C. in honor of her contribution to AZ.

#### Meet Tom Leard; Our newest member of the Board



Tom spent his teenage years in Columbus, Ohio. He graduated from Ohio State University with a degree in electrical engineering. Eventually, after he and his family moved to Phoenix, he completed his master's in business administration at Arizona State University.

He worked in industry for a short while before he went on active duty and Air Force flight school. The first half of his active duty time was in tactical flying operations.

The second half was flying in the strategic forces. He joined Sperry Flight Systems in mid-1974. By late 1978, he returned to full time flying as a company avionics development and demonstration pilot. In addition to contributing to the makeover of flight operations into an engineering focused organization, he introduced a formalized methodology for the evaluation of the human centered design aspects of flight deck products and systems.

In early 1989 he transferred to the Bell Rd organization for a series of start-up team leadership roles in Product Support and Displays. Throughout this era, he continued to fly as a company staff pilot. After retirement (2004) from (by then) Honeywell, he worked for a start-up company developing a new generation of instrument approaches. His 'last 'assignment was managing his own avionics evaluation and certification consulting company.

Tom and his wife Barbara have two daughters and two grandsons. Volunteering in the community has always been a keen interest of both Tom and Barb. After retirement, Tom became involved in the Carefree Kiwanis, CAF air museum in Mesa, and their homeowner's association.

They both enjoy traveling to many parts of the world. They reside in Carefree.







# Ping Factory Tour



On Oct  $31^{st}$  a group of us toured the factory. I know absolutely nothing about golf so I will not embarrass myself with a long description. However the tour for me was fascinating, full of details and over 2 hours long. And you really do walk at least  $\frac{1}{2}$  a mile.

The facility is their main design and production site with 800 employees out of a worldwide workforce of 1500. We toured everywhere from custom bag manufacturing, putter head milling, assembly of the clubs at various stages, driving range and the vault.

There was some famous PGA player trying out new clubs on a very nice test range. The picture above is the vault with over 3400 gold plated and solid gold putters. Apparently if you win a big championship using Ping clubs they make a gold putter for you and keep a replica in the vault.

We discovered that the next day (Nov 1st) they were introducing a variable length putter to the market. Apparently 80% of players use the wrong length.

This has been a popular event and all three dates (Nov 9th and Nov 29th) are fully booked.


