Ping Factory Tour

New Dates - Feb 15th & 27th 2019



The Ping Gold Room is a vault, and yes the putters you see are gold. Any player that wins a tour event with a Ping putter gets that putter gold plated and one goes in the vault.

Any player that wins a Major Tournament gets a solid gold putter and one goes in the vault.

On Nov 29th a group of us toured the factory. I know absolutely nothing about golf so I will not embarrass myself with a long description. However the tour for me was fascinating, full of details and over 2 hours long. And you really do walk at least ½ a mile.

The facility is their main design and production site with 800 employees out of a worldwide workforce of 1500. We toured everywhere from custom bag manufacturing, putter head milling, assembly of the clubs at various stages, driving range and the vault.

There was some famous PGA player trying out new clubs on a very nice test range. The picture above is the vault with over 3400 gold plated and solid gold putters. Apparently if you win a big championship using Ping clubs they make a gold putter for you and keep a replica in the vault.

We discovered that the next day (Nov 1st) they were introducing a variable length putter to the market. Apparently 80% of players use the wrong length.

This has been a popular event and all three dates (Oct 31st, Nov 9th and Nov 29th) are fully booked.

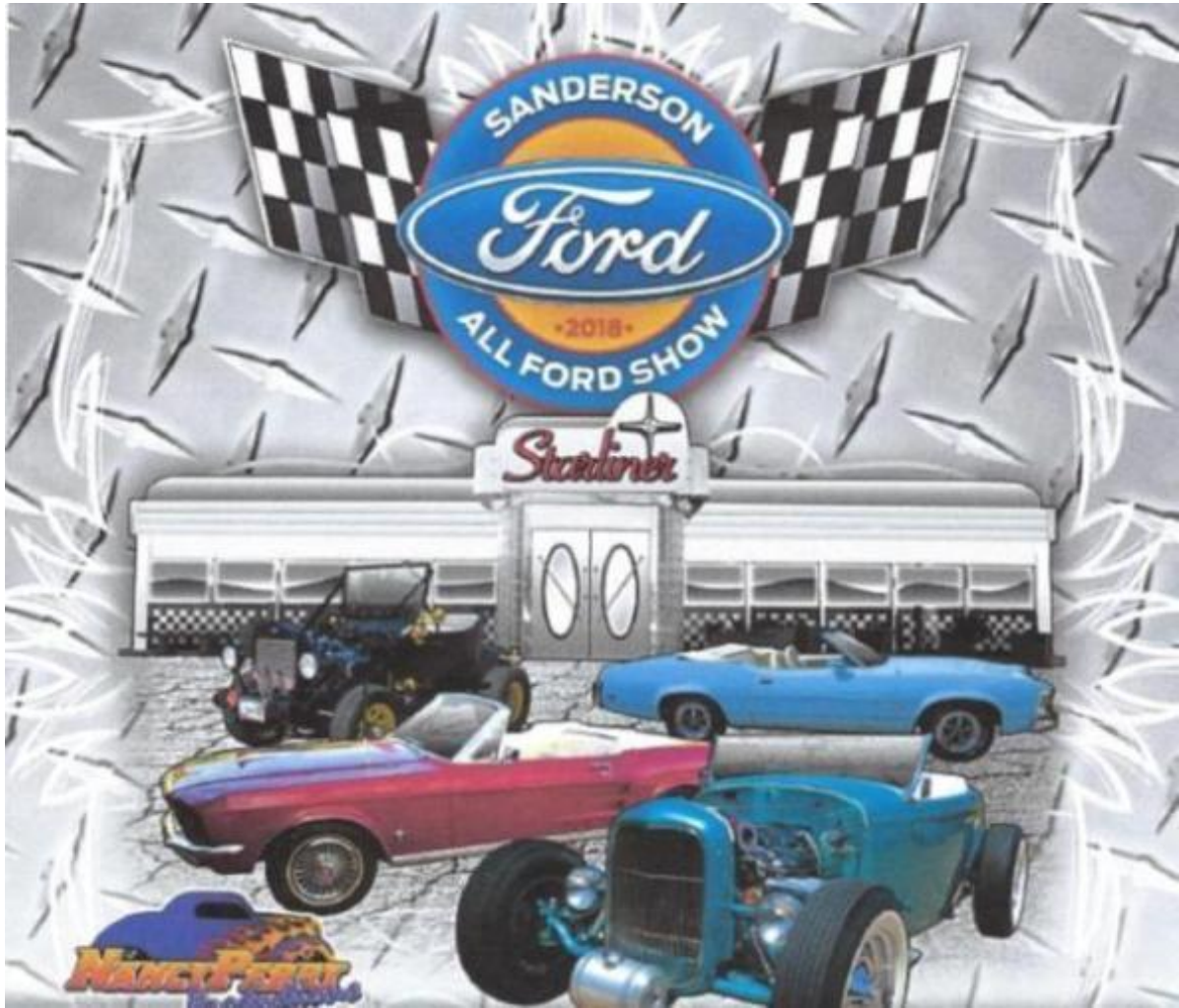
